



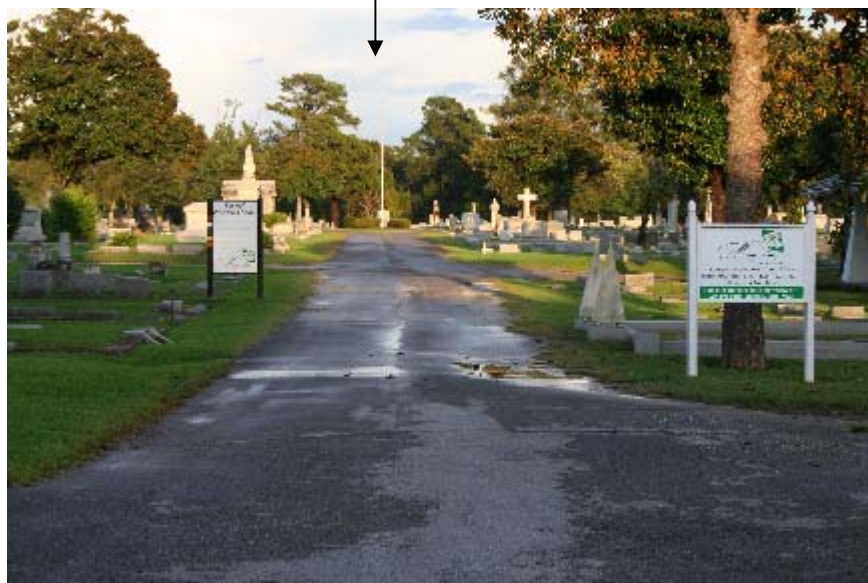

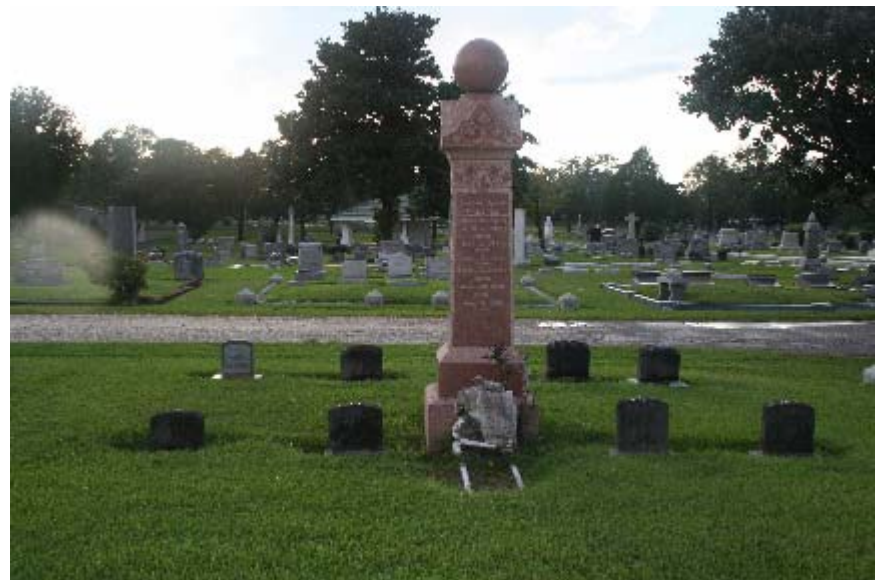

The headstone writings face away from the branch road.

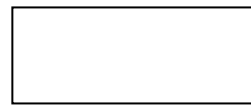
